A person may be eligible as an Affiliate member for a maximum period of three years only before being required to apply for Accredited level.	Must have a strong industry background in a marine-related business, or have passed a relevant diploma-level qualification or above in an applicable subject, and intend to, or are already, practising wholly or part-time in surveying or designing.	1.
